Target Audience

American Heart Association BLS Healthcare providers who would like to become instructors in basic life support.

Objectives

Upon completion of this course, participants should be able to:

- Teach a BLS course using the video and lesson maps;
- Use testing materials to conduct skills testing;
- Facilitate a session where they will be able to:
 - Instruct a group on practice-while-watching the video;
 - Successfully evaluate another instructor candidate while correctly using the skills-testing checklist; and
